We are still behind on conversions *, but some of you have requested a hold waiting on the new technology batteries, so it's not so bad. More on that below. We see such a demand for conversions even in their current state - with lead acid batteries. We are now requesting a deposit to confirm your position in line for a conversion, and half of the estimated cost upon the start of the job. If we are to find your "donor" car for you, we request a purchase deposit as well (that was we know you are serious and will have your money on hand for immediate purchase). We are still small, and the deposits help us to get to your conversion as soon as possible. Please see our website for sponsorship opportunities as well. A short investment will yield 10% profit upon completion of your sponsored conversion's delivery. Email us if you or your company or organization are interested. The faster we get quality usable EVs on the road NOW, the faster we help clean up the air and reduce our dependence on OIL.

* The Lithium Iron Phosphate batteries have been tested though out the summer in the original Ampmobile, a 1986 S-10 pick-up truck. The prototype batteries in this heavy (at least for an EV) vehicle can allow us close to a 100 mile range per charge at normal driving speeds. The performance difference was similar to going from a 4-cylinder to 8-cylinder vehicle. Our next project is a practical conversion - using a late model (or hopefully new), light weight 4-5 passenger car. We feel this is the next step to achieving our goal of EVs in everyday use, being able to drive normal speeds while allowing for the comforts standard to modern day cars, trucks, light weight vans, and smaller SUVs. The life expectancy and number of charge cycles far surpass those of lead acid batteries, while the difference in weight automatically improve the vehicle's performance and range. We will have more information and pricing at our website as soon as we know ourselves. The possibilities for these batteries is limitless, in NEVs (neighborhood electric vehicles) and EVs (electric vehicles), even regular golf carts.

Workshops are possibly coming to Ampmobile Conversions in 2008. We are still working out details, prices and a schedule. More information should be available in the next e-mail newsletter. We hope to have at least a few full conversion and some "mini" workshops concentrating on specific aspects of a conversion. Again, all details and such are being worked on right now - so there is nothing more specific at this time. (Sorry!)

We have a lot of things still in the works for this year, as well as getting a few more conversions completed and delivered before the New year! Look for the next update after Thanksgiving!
